If your horse is on a different vaccination schedule, please let me know as well for our records. If your horse is due for teeth, sheath cleaning or further shots it will be added to the follow-up clinic with Dr. Peralez later in November.

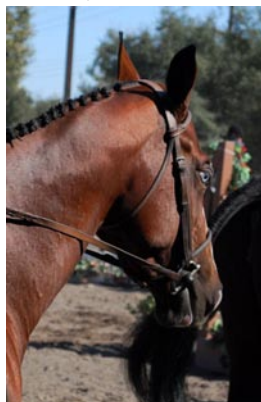


Latino History Day Parade

Sand for Stalls

- Full Stall (approx. 8 tons) - \$171.68
- Half Stall (approx. 4 tons) - \$85.84
